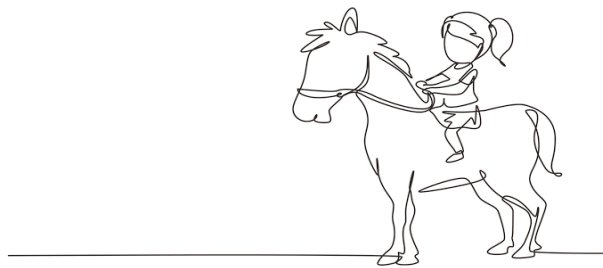

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ENTERING THIS COMPETITION CONSTITUTES ACKNOWLEDGEMENT THAT PCV/PCA RULES APPLY AND ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES.

The organising Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.

No refunds after closing date except with a vet or medical certificate.

PCV membership cards must be inspected at the office before riding, on the day of competition on penalty of elimination. In accordance with PCV Bylaw 15.7.a .ii Grading must not be corrected or altered at a competition.

Gymkhana Competitors are to collect their tickets and competitor number at the office, in the morning on the day.

GEAR CHECK. Required for all riders before competing as per the current PCA Gear Rules. The rules are available here. Please check them prior to the event to avoid disappointment <https://ponyclubaustralia.com.au/wp-content/uploads/2020/06/PCA-National-Gear-Rules-2023.pdf> The responsibility to ride in the correct competition gear remains with the competitor. If any judge or official discovers a competitor riding with incorrect competition gear, elimination may occur. **Each ring will commence Gear check 15mins prior to ring start time.**

GAMES: • Competitors may ride more than one horse subject to the conditions of the current PCV Handbook of Bylaws multiple horse rules • A horse may only be ridden by one rider. • Horses/ponies must be at least 4 years old on the day of the competition. • No plaiting whips or spurs. Snaffle bits only. No earrings. Under mounting (horse too small for rider) is not permitted.

Dogs are prohibited with the exception of Assistance Dogs.

DISCLAIMER. Neither the organising committee of this competition, clinic or activity nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.

All Non-Pony Club members, and any Pony Club member who cannot show their Pony Club card or prove Pony Club membership must complete the day participant waiver and liability declaration: Non-Pony Club members and PCA/PCV members who cannot prove their PCA/PCV membership must pay \$20 per day of participation unless exempt by way of holding insurance (as per Page 4 -Liability Declaration) with an equine organization or hold their own insurance. All Non-Pony Club members, and any Pony Club member who cannot show their Pony Club card or prove Pony Club membership must provide the relevant forms to the organizing committee BEFORE riding on the day of the competition/activity on penalty of elimination. GYMKHANA PRICES

Online Ticket entries close on the 22th of September. Prepaid tickets will be available to collect on the day. Please purchase tickets via **Event Secretary**. There will be no entries available on the day.

VINTAGE RING- \$25 allows you to enter as many classes as you are eligible for, in one ring.

SPRINGERS RING- \$25 allows you to enter as many classes as you are eligible for, in one ring.

TIPSY RING and TOPSY RING- \$25 allows you to enter as many classes as you are eligible for, in the one ring.

STOCKMANS CHALLENGE- \$5 per attempt. 1 timed attempt allowed.

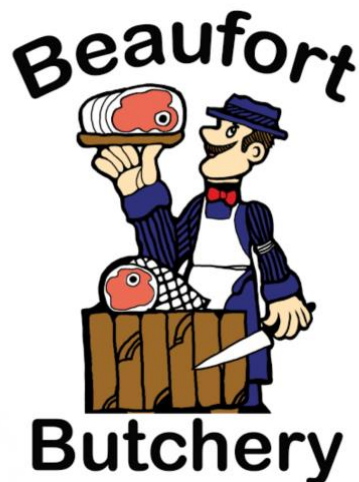
FANCY DRESS- \$5

BARREL RACE-\$5 per timed game attempt. One practice, ONE timed round allowed.

FACILITY FEE- \$10 per vehicle.

YARD/STALL FEE- \$10 per horse. Optional. Limited availability.

INSURANCE- \$20 for non - PCV riders unless exempt by way of holding insurance (as per Page 4 -Liability Declaration) with an equine organization or hold their own insurance.

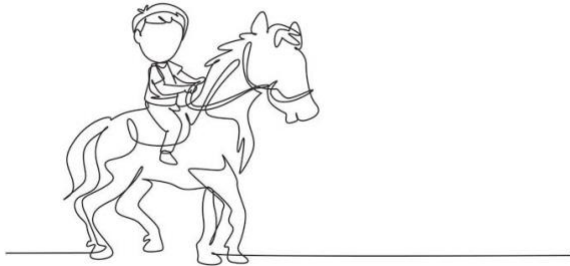


CANTEEN AND COFFEE VAN OPERATING ON THE DAY

GAME RULES

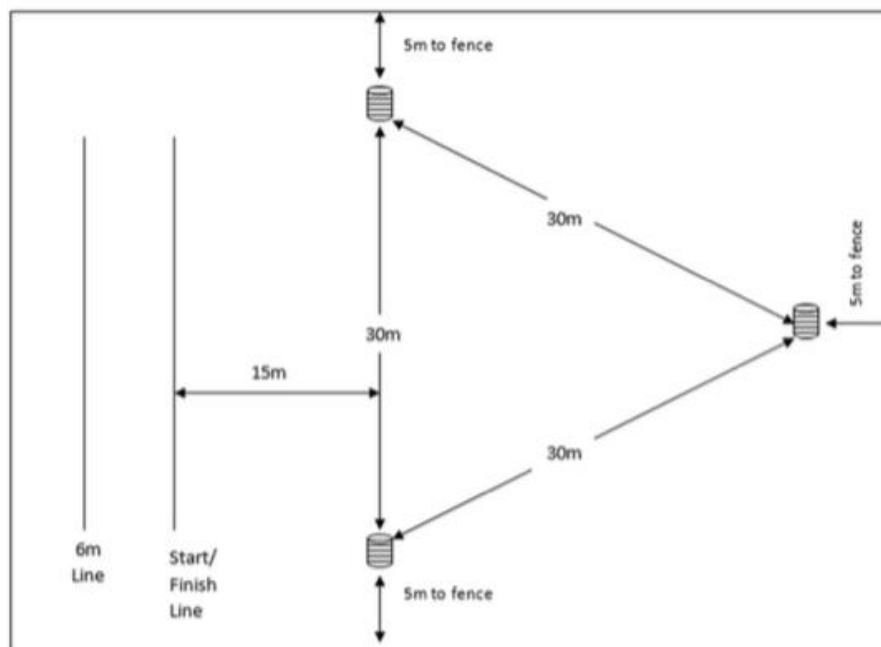
BARREL RACE

Equipment:

- 3 x 200 Litre Drums
- Start & Finish Poles

Set Up:

Barrels must be at least five metres from a fence. The distance between each drum is 30 metres and the start/finish line is 15 metres from the first two drums. The starting and finishing line and the position of the drums must be marked permanently for the competition.



Rules:

- Contestants may go to either right or left barrel first but must make two left hand and one right hand turns; or two right hand and one left hand turn. TRACKS MUST BE CROSSED AFTER EACH DRUM.
- The start will be a standing start from a six-metre box, with time taken as horse's nose crosses start finish line.
- each horse will have one practice run and one timed run.

Penalties:

- Each Barrel knocked over - Five (5) second penalty
- Failing to cross tracks after each drum - Elimination

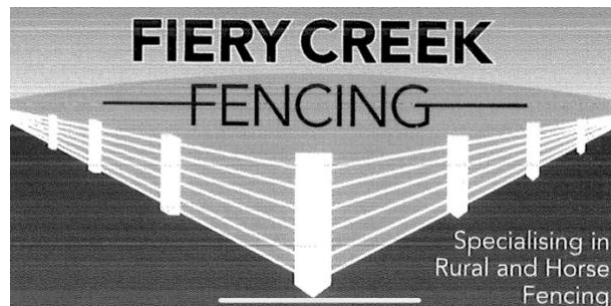
