**Cross Country Course**

The Course is relatively flat terrain with mixed sandy soils and irrigated pasture & includes both permanent and transportable type fences. There are *two water complexes* and good open grassed country for galloping. The EvA50, EvA65, EvA80 & EvA95 courses are very encouraging for young or inexperienced horse and rider combinations.

This Event is run under FEI Rules [www.fei.org](http://www.fei.org) and EA [www.equestrian.org.au](http://www.equestrian.org.au) Eventing Rules 2026. It is the responsibility of riders to know these Rules. Riders must be a member of EA.

**Entries close on Wed 4 March 2026 OR when classes are full.**

**The EvA50 and EvA65 classes will all be held on the Saturday of the competition – all three phases and presentations.**

***That the Organising Committee has been granted an exemption to EA Eventing Rule 536.5, and that an open training clinic was held on the course 13 days prior to competition. Participants in that clinic are exempted from any rule breach.***

**Refund Policy**

Should the committee need to cancel this event due to any reason, we will be referring to the Eventing Australia Refund Policy:

Cancelled competitions

- Entry fees, camping fees and stable/yard fees will be refunded less an administration fee of up to 50% for cancelled competitions.
- Cancelled competitions are competitions that have not commenced any phases.

Should you be ill, or display any symptoms of Covid-19, please scratch and do not attend. We will be referring to the Eventing Australia Refund Policy and refunds will be dealt with on a case by case basis :

Refund policy

1. Refunds can only be negotiated through the Organising Committee for each competition, special circumstances may be dealt with on a case by case basis with the OC.
2. Withdrawal of entries prior to the advertised original close of entries date will be refunded with no more than 20% deducted as an administration fee. Entries means entry fee only, NOT stabling, start fee, ground fees.
3. Rider Start Fee must be refunded in full if a rider does not start the dressage phase. No deductions from this fee.
4. there will be no refund of entries for withdrawals after the originally published close of entries date unless there are entries on a waiting list, for the same level as the withdrawal, in which case the entry will be refunded less a 20% administration fee

**WITHDRAWALS** must be made by the competitor via the online entry system up to the closing date. Withdrawals after the closing date will be in accordance with EA National Eventing Rules effective January 2025. All withdrawals after the closing date must be emailed and substantiated to the event secretary [capelhpcevents@gmail.com](mailto:capelhpcevents@gmail.com) Any refunds will be at the discretion of the organising committee. A partial refund will be given depending on the amount of notice given and whether the helper duty is completed.

**TEAMS EVENT:**

1. Four (4) riders (where entered) will be selected by the Organising Committee, with one rider drawn from each of four (4) different classes.
2. At the conclusion of each competition, the rider with the highest individual score will be dropped from the team total.
3. Teams will be carried across all three events held at the Capel Regional Equestrian Grounds:
  - Capel
  - Futures
  - Swan
4. The entry fee is **\$5 per horse/rider** each event.
5. Prize money will also be awarded to the top three teams based on the best **overall results across all two of the three events:**
  - **1st Place:** \$800
  - **2nd Place:** \$400
  - **3rd Place:** \$200

**ENTRIES**

All riders please note:

All riders intending to compete at Capel Event will need to renew their 2026 Equestrian WA membership prior to the event. All membership numbers will be checked and if not current, fully paid & with the appropriate competition licence (EvA95 and above) you will be unable to compete.

Class sizes are limited and will be closed when full. Entries are to be made only via Event Secretary online system. A \$50 late fee may apply if late entry or class changes accepted

**OFF THE TRACK REBATE**

OTTWA are offering a 30% rebate on OTT entries that live 150kms from Capel Horse and Pony Club and start at the event.

The 150kms will be calculated as the shortest route on Google maps from your residential address Entrants competing on TBs and STBs that have an OTTWA Passport are eligible for the rider rebate.

You must enter passport details and postcode on Event Secretary BEFORE entries close

Please note – the rebate is on the entry fee only, not on levies, ground fees etc and will be refunded to riders who start at the event after the conclusion of the event

### **HELPERS**

Even though we have asked what your preferred helper duty is on Event Secretary, this is only an indication. We need to ensure that we have the best volunteers completing the tasks.

Self-help is available to riders with one horse ONLY. Self-help is NOT available to riders of more than one horse, unless completed prior to the event. Competitors may attend a Busy Bee prior to the event or assist with set up, course flagging etc. depending on requirements, helper spots for these jobs are limited. Helpers should be prepared for up to a 4 hour helper duty either Sat or Sun and the duty time is fixed.

*Please do not request a change of helper duty time because you want to go home early. EVERYONE wants to get home, along with the organising committee, and your helper duty is imperative for the completion of the event. Requests such as this can incur a black mark against your competitors name, and not being able to attend future events held at Capel.*

**Please use the comments section in your entry if you have a specific helper request. Eg. Helper is only available Saturday, or I need a job when my child is not riding so I can help them etc. We will do our very best to give you a job which suits you and your helper. This is far easier to do while we allocate jobs as opposed to once the jobs have been done. Please help us to help you!**

Cross Country Data Base -

Capel Horse and Pony Club will be engaging the use of the Helper Duty Data Base.

Paid data base helpers must be entered on Event Secretary with a "DB" in front of the helper you have been allocated, and their phone number.

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS**

1. I acknowledge and agree that:

  - b. horses may act in a sudden and unpredictable manner, and EWA does not make any representations or warranties as to how a horse may act; and
  - c. I participate in any event held or managed by EWA, or coaching services provided by EWA or a member coach of EWA (**Activities**), at my OWN RISK.
2. I have read, understood and agree to abide by this Waiver and Release of Liability, all and any rules, regulations, policies and codes (including the Code of Conduct) of EWA, and any organiser or manager of Activities, as may be in force from time to time, and acknowledge and agree that:
