Arrivals, Camping and Parking

All horse arrivals on Friday 4 September are to be between 10.00am and 10.00pm. Please note our Stable Manager is on duty from 10.00am to 10.00pm for access to stables on Friday and Saturday. All stables are provided with four bales of bedding – if you have ordered extra, these will be in your stable. During the event, more can be bought from the event office.

All camping will be in the North or South truck park. Please do not occupy a space next to a power outlet in either parking area unless you have booked powered camping. Day parking will also be available in Area P9.



Cabins

If you have booked a cabin, please collect the key from the event office.

Scratchings and refunds

Class entry fees which include the compulsory EvNSW levy are not refundable after closing date, and no further levy, day stays or facility fees will be refunded after Thursday night.

Protocol sessions and arena hire – Friday 4 September

Protocol sessions will be held in Arenas 9 and 10 and hired arenas are Arenas 7 and 8. Please make sure you arrive in good time for your session – protocol test papers and pencilers are provided.

Arena 4 will be available for warm up until 6.00pm on Friday 4 and Saturday 5 September only.

Dressage – 5 September

Warm up for dressage in Arenas 7, 8, 9 and 10 will be in Arena 4.
Warm up for dressage in Hack Arenas 1, 2 and 3 will be in Arena 13.

Show Jumping 5 and 6 September

Warm up for show jumping in Arena 1 (Olympic arena) will be in Arena 1.
Warm up for show jumping in Arena 12 will be in Arena 14

Cross Country 5 and 6 September

Cross country courses will be available for walking from early afternoon Friday 4 September. Note the gates between SIEC and the Western Sydney Parklands are closed at 6pm. Maps will be on the XC App on Friday afternoon once signed off by the Technical Delegates.

Warm up for EvA 65, EvA 80 and EvA 95 will be in the warm up area above the start box.
Warm up for 1*, 2*, 3* and 4* will be in the middle of the steeplechase track.

Cross country will be run in strict number order, and will be a move up draw if running ahead of schedule. Allowances will be made for riders with multiple rides.

Vets

There will be two vets on site on competition days, courtesy of our naming rights sponsor, University of Sydney, Equine Centre Camden. If your horse becomes sick whilst at SIEC, please notify the Stable Manager and the Office.

Farrier

The farrier will be located near the stables. Please ask at the office if you need his services.

Falls

Please note that if you have a fall at any time during the competition, you must be tested and cleared by either a paramedic or the doctor and your horse must be cleared by a vet. It is your responsibility to ensure this happens.

Helmet tagging

Please make every effort to have your helmet tagged prior to the event. If you do need a helmet tagged please come to the event office and we will contact one of our helmet taggers.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome at SIEC but must be on a lead at all times. There will be a \$100 fine imposed for any dogs found running loose not only in the competition areas but also round the stables and parking areas.

E-Scooters / Motorised bicycles

E-Scooters and skate boards are not allowed anywhere at SIEC, being a public space (Transport NSW rule). Motorised bicycles are allowed, but not on the cross country course when a class is progress. Helmets must be worn.

Refund of stable bonds

Stable bonds will be refunded in the week following the event on receipt of a clean report from SIEC. Shovels and barrows are available for use and used bedding is to be placed in the skip bins.

Rubbish

Please take as much of your rubbish home as possible – this way we can keep the SIEC cleaning charges (and therefore your entry fees) to a minimum.

Merchandise

Sydney Eventing polo shirts, base layers and baseball caps are available at the office.

Scoring

Live scoring is provided by Event Secretary. Results are available for the event (21878) on the Event Secretary noticeboard, and your detailed results and dressage sheets can be found under results in your own Event Secretary account.

Presentation and prizes

There will be no formal presentation or prize giving – placegetters should come to the office to collect rugs, rosettes and prizes once results are signed off. These will not be posted.

Prize money will be given for classes EvA 95, CCI 1*, CCN 2*, CCN 3* and CCN 4* whilst prizes will be given for classes EvA 65 and EvA 80. There will also be the highest placed eligible OTTB award in each division of each class – generously sponsored by **Yulong Stud, Nagambie, Victoria**. The highest placed junior will be recognized in the * classes.

Any prize money not claimed within two months will be considered forfeited.
